

Basic Inspection Points Chain Saws

Daily:

- ◆ Inspect the air filter.
- ◆ Are the chain brake, chain catcher, and throttle lock in working order?
- ◆ Is the saw chain tightened properly?
- ◆ Inspect the handles, guards, and controls for wear and tear.
- ◆ Is the muffler operational?
- ◆ Check all screws, nuts, and bolts. Secure them, but do not overtighten.
- ◆ Has the fuel been mixed properly and is it stored in a flammable container?
- ◆ Check fuel and bar oil levels.
- ◆ Clean around fuel and oil caps before and after fueling.

Weekly:

- ◆ Clean and grease clutch drum bearing.
- ◆ Inspect chain and sprocket
- ◆ Clean air intake slots.
- ◆ Inspect ignition plug.
- ◆ Lube starter sheave bearing.
- ◆ Inspect starter cord and handle.
- ◆ Clean muffler.

Monthly:

- ◆ Inspect and replace the fuel filter if necessary.
- ◆ Adjust carburetor if necessary.
- ◆ Inspect chain break band and clutch.
- ◆ Flush fuel and bar oil tanks.
- ◆ Check cables and connections.
- ◆ Brush debris off cylinder fins.
